<u>Safety Brief by Stuart Wetterschneider</u>: Many Airstreams are connected to the tow vehicle using a Hensley hitch, one of the best weight distributing, anti sway hitches on the market. If you use the Hensley it is important that you follow the directions of the manufacturer when you hook up. For example, if you fail to check if the struts are loose, and in fact they are loose, your Airstream will start swaying from side to side when you are passed by a large vehicle in any direction. Not a good situation. When you are checking to see if the struts are tight be sure to check when the springs bars are NOT under tension.
